County, was involved at summer camp last year (1969) for the same offense He was contacted by the State Police and questioned but not charged but his statement is on record with the States Attorney. James Knowlton, an asst. SH also was thirdived and has since gone to college in Louisiana. Charges were not prought are that any of the nen but each has his statemen on record with the State attorney in Leonardton, Md.

On finding cut this information I called the committee of the Troop to ;a meeting the reiv day and Mr. White was told not to come into contac with any of the boys of the troop from this time forward. Mr. Fulton cal me from longs was County and stated he would no longer be active with an Scouting more with and knows he will be placed on a confidential listing. The Knowled, then ranger at Camp Roosevelt, called me and I set up a meeting between Mr. Howard Kautz and Knowlton. He stated his part in the activity and was immediatly released from employment and told he too would be placed on the confidential listing.
