He was in training to become a Brother in the Augustinian Order with the Augustinian Monastery at Lansdowne Avenue and Garrett Road, Drexel Hill, Pa. He is now under psychiatric treatment-parents divorced. This matter was reviewed and his removal from the Order was substantiated by Archdiocesan Scout Chaplain, Father Francis Schmidt.

Dear Mr. Ry,

This letter is in reference to our telephone conversation of November 4th, at which time we reported to you the misconduct of one Mr. Michael Gallagher (who assists at scott meetings and camping trips) with our son, scout of troop 346.

We submit as per your request the facts of this incident as told us by our son, as well as another incident in the summer encampment at camp Delmar.

On Friday night, Oct. 28th. 1966, our son spent the night at the apartment of Mr. Gallagher in preparation for an early departure for a week end camping trip to camp Unimar. It this time our son was approached by Mr. Gallagher and instructed to remove his trousers for a physical examination. Remembering the revision given by a decimal a physical examination. Remembering the physical given by a doctor before summer camp, complied, only to have his organs probed and fondled. A second time that right, was told to lie down for more examination, and when he resisted, and called out, was silenced forcefully. Mr. Gallagher also made tark recordings of contrasts. forcefully. Mr. Gallagher also made tape recordings of answers to questions like - " What would you to if you were alone with a girl in the woods - would you take off your clothes and hold hands " etc.

On questioning he further revealed (for the first time) that Mr. Gallagher had done these things to him and to one or two

other boys during the summer camping trip to Delmar.

Mrs. and I deeply apprecate your concern and interest in this matter and regret very much that such an incident should occur during a scouting program. We trust that this situation will be remedied and Mr. Gallagher will be apprehended for his conduct, and prevented from inflicting more serious injury to another child in the future.
