

RE: John Duckworth Carland 3339 S. Fifth Street Hartsville, South Carolina

On 8-25-66 the above-named man was assigned to a 12 year old Little Brother. This case was terminated on 2-1-67 for the following reason: The Big Brother caseworker in Hartsville was contacted by the Little Brother concerning a problem he had encountered with his Big Brother. During a personal interview with the Little Brother, it was learned that Mr. Garland would invite the Little Brother to his home to watch football games on the weekends. Mr. Garland began removing various parts of his clothing. This progressed weekly, becoming more serious each week. The breaking point for this boy was when the Big Brother removed his pants and masturbated in front of the Little Brother on the previous weekend. After consultation with the Big Brother's pastor and others we felt the Little Brother was telling the truth and a termination should be made immediately.
