ORDER

Now on this 14th day of January, 1969, this matter comes on for hearing upon the information on file herein at the request of the defendant who appears in person and with his attorney Geo. W. Stanley. Plaintiff appears by Mike Smith, County Attorney, CowleyCounty, Kansas.

Whereupon the information as filed herein charging the defendant with felonious solicitation of a minor to commit an immoral act as set forth in K.S.A. 38-711 is presented and read to the defendant and thereafter the Court inquires of the defendant if he understands the nature of the offense and his rights relative thereto and whether or not he has discussed the same with his counsel to which the defendant states that he understands the nature of the offense charged, that he has discussed his rights in connection therewith at length with his counsel and is well advised in the premises.

Whereupon the court inquires of the defendant is he is ready to enter a pleat to the offense as charged and as read to him to witch the defendant states that he is ready to plead and does exter a plea of guilty thereto.

Whereupon the court inquires of the parties or either of them if they have any reason to show why sentence should not now be pranounced and the defendant and his counsel make a request that the court defer sentence pending a mental examination in accordance with K.S.A. 62-1534 and 1535.

Whereupon the Court finds that said request should be complied with and does defer sentencing the defendant pending a mental examination.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE COURT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Sheriff of Cowley County, Kansas, shall take into custody and transport the defendant, William H. Goatley to the Larned State Hospital, Larned, Kansas, there to be committed for mental examination and report to this Court all at the expense of the State of Kansas.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of the report of said hospital this Court will further consider the matter.
