

It was found that Scoutmaster Theodore W. White, Asst. Scoutmasters Charles Fulton and James Knowlton had committed indecent sets with boys of the troop.

This came to light when one father, Mr. Called me for a meeting and when we met stated that Mr. Ted white had committed indecent acts with his son. He stated that he had talked with the State Attorney, Mr. Joseph Weiner and they had confinited the with the facts as they knew them. He, Mr. White, stated it was true and that he decided not to press charg would go under the Doctors care. for the boys sake and because he personally knew Mr. White for some time Officer Potts of the Maryland State Police Was the investigating officer for the case and found that 3 or the boys printerinvolved to some extent. was also found that the Asst. Charles Fulton, since moved to Montgon County, was involved at summer camp that year (1969) for the same offens He was contacted by the State Police and questioned but not charged but his statement is on record with the States Attorney. James Knowlton, ar asst. SM also was invelved and has since gone to college in Louisiana. fought against any of the men but each has his stateme Charges were not by on record with State Stattorney in Leonardtown, Md.

On finding out the information I called the committee of the Troop to ;a meeting the next day and Mr. White was told not to come into cents with any of the towns of the troop from this time forward. Mr. Fulton came from Montgorery County and stated he would no longer be active with a Scouting movement and knows he will be placed on a confidential listing. Knowlight then ranger at Camp Roosevelt, called me and I set up a meeting between Mr. Howard Kautz and Knowlton. He stated his part in the activity and was immediatly released from employment and told he too wor
