Howard Kautz referred your letter to me in which you inquired about William Hoffmeyer.

Bill Hoffmeyer was active in the Mational Capital Area Council while I was Scout executive. At the outside he did a very good job for us working with the Order of the Arrow and as one of our camp directors in our summer patrol camp operation (jamboree style).

He was a Humanics student at Salem College and we had been cultivating him for the career service. We considered him a better than average prospect.

Fortunately, word got to me that he might be involved in perversion. I called him in and although I was unable to get any clear out statement or evidence that he was guilty, there was sufficient "muddy water" that I refused to approve his application for the career service. I told him that he would have to change his ways before I would be in a position to give him any further endorsement for Scouting.

His counsellor and other professors at Salem College called on me to relent my position, feeling that his case had been over-stated by boys in camp the were trying to get back at him because of his discipline tactics. In spite of their pleading I could not compromise. As a result, Bill Hoffmeyer is not in the career service and he moved from our area.

It is my considered opinion that from what you have described in your letter, Bill should still be kept out of Scouting.
