Dear Parky:

A Mr. William R. Legare stopped into this office yesterday to discuss with me why we would not accept his registration as Scoutmaster of Troop 125 (Nat'l. 1125) in Woonsocket. In the course of the conversation I discovered that Mr. Legare is currently registered as Assistant Scoutmaster of Troop 13 (Nat'l. 1121) in Woonsocket. It is for this latter reason that I am writing you.

Mr. Legare is a 21 year old single individual who is attending college in Rhode Island. He first came to our attention one and one half years ago, he was then 19 years old and a student at McNeese State College in Lake Charles, Louisiana. He was also serving as Assistant Scontmaster of Troop 133 in Lake Charles.

We have police records indicating certain unmatural acts were committed which Mr. Legare admits, although he indicates that they were "college pranks". Pranks or not, because they are of a serious morals nature, we cannot accept Mr. Legare's registration as Scoutmaster and we must apologize to you that in some unexplained manner his registration as Assistant Scoutmaster of Troop 13 did not get caught.

Mr. Legare's activities in connection with Troop 13, as well as his potential relationship with Troop 125 should both be immediately stopped. Mr. Legare has been advised of this by me personally and he has been further advised that we will never again, at least in the foreseeable future, knowingly accept his registration in the Boy Scouts of America.

Dear Howard:

It becomes my duty to place two men on the red flag list. They are Mr. William Legare, white male, age 19 in 1967; and Mr. Dennis Kelly Ryan, white male, age 56 in 1967.

I am enclosing a statement made to the cfty police department by Mr. Ryan on Sept. 2, 1967. Mr. Ryan is no longer registered in Scouting, but he will probably always be in Lake Charles. He has not been registered during the past nine years that I have been in this council, but before then he was an outstanding Sea Scout Skipper. I do not believe that he will ever try to register in Scouting, because he knows better. He is employed by the Louisiana State Employment Commission and has a responsible job. He is a white male, about 5' 8" tall weighing about 190 pounds, ruddy complexion and thin hair.

William Legare will probably try to register in Scouting again. He was convicted on August 24, 1967 for "Un-natural Copulation with Juveniles" (two counts), and sentenced to six months in jail on each count. He has left Lake Charles. He is currently registered as Assistant Scoutmaster of Troop 133 in Lake Charles, Las and probably has a registration card which expires in Banuary, 1967. He was on the camp staff this summer, but the camp director let him go after about four weeks, "because he just didn't seem to fit in". It was after this time that the incident took place that caused him to be reported and convicted.

Legare is about 5' 11" tall, black hair, average complexion and weighs about 165 pounds. He originally came from the Eastern part of the United States and Lifeel sure that he went back up there. He was enrolled in McNeese State College here in Lake Charles.

In fact, it seems that I sent his name in for the preview plan late in 1966, but I don't find a record of this. If you do have a record then it may show the place he came from.
