Mrs. stated that had been approached by a Mr Robert Mates (Parkway Dist Trng Chm) who was working as a leader with the Troop (consolidated), on Aug 3. Mr. Mates had asked to have a sexy party' and the thinking Bob meant sexy pictures, said yes. About 12 P.M., Bob came to leanto & asked him if he'd like to 'play with his penis'. Not to appear afraid, said all right & 'enjoyed' the experience, but refused Bobs requests for further activity, pleading tiredness and finally, that this was not a moral act. Bob then returned to his own leanto after after asking to tell no-one.

Mrs. further stated that she had promised her son not to tell anyone what had happened, but she thought it was in fact necessary to take some positive steps to prevent further problems. She would leave her som at Kunatah as originally planned.
