Dear Mr. Daniels:

The above named subject has been investigated on two separate occasions for two separate and distinct offenses concerning the committing of lewd and indecent acts on adolescent males.

The first offense, August 2, 1965, involved a sixteen year old boy, and the second offense, September 8, 1966, involved a fifteen year old boy. In both cases, it is alleged that this subject inticed these boys into going with him to a private and secluded place, and that prior to making lewd and indecent proposals and advances he showed each of them pictures of naked men and women.

Reports concerning the invest gations of both of these incidents are on file in the County Attorney's Office of Washington County, Oklahoma.

At the present time this subject has not been charged with either offense. However, charges are pending against this subject for the offense of September 8, 1966, depending on the outcome of the psychiatric treatment which this subject is now undergoing.

Because this subject has had some contact with the scouting program in the past, our office feels that your organization should be informed of this situation. We know that your organization will hold this information in confidence. If you desire any further information concerning this matter, please contact us at your earliest convenience.
