Dear Mr. Boyd:

This letter is transmitting information pertaining to the removal of Mr. David H. Mitchell, 250 N. Warwick Street, Westmont, Illinois, from registration with the Boy Scouts of America. He has been registered as a Pack Committeman of Pack 7 of Westmont; Illinois, and as a Neighborhood Commissioner with the West Suburban Council. Also, Mr. Mitchell has been listed as a Merit Badge Counselor in the Indian Trails District.

On June 27th, at approximately 10:30 p.m., a phone call informed me that Mr. Mitchell had been involved in an indecent liberty in his home with a Scout, while in the matter of the Scout being examined for a Merit Badge. On the morning of June 28th, the Scout described to our Assistant Scout Executive, Mr. William Monical, the circumstances of the incident. The description was recorded and accompanies this communication. I held a conference with the mother of the Scout, and outlined to her the marner in which the incident would be investigated and the actions which we would initiate in respect to Mr. Mitchell.

Mr. Mitchell was contacted and asked to come to the CouncilService Center after coming home from his job. At 6:45 p.m. Mr. Monical and I met with him. The circumstances of the incident as we had it recorded were read to him. He admitted that the described circumstances had occurred, and admitted his involvement. He said he had a problem with this type of behavior earlier in his life, and had thought in recent years had it under control.

Mr. Mitchell was informed that his registration was terminated with the Boy Scours of America. He was told that he was to have no future associations with Scouting personnel nor to in any way relate himself to Scouting activities or endeavors.

This letter and the attached information is for placing on file to support the listing of Mr. David H. Mitchell as an undesirable person to in any way be connected with the Boy Scouts of America.

A DESCRIPTION OF CIRCUMSTANCES INVOLVING AN INDECENT LIBERTY BY MR. DAVID H. MITCHELL

The Scout identified the Merit Badge Counselor as Mr. David Ĥ. Mitchell, 250 N. Warwick Street, Westmont, Illinois.

The Merit Badge Counseling Conference took place at the home of Mr. David H. Mitchell, 250 N. Warwick Street, Westmont, Lilinois on the evening of June 27, 1966. Present in the room watching television was the wife of Mr. Mitchell, and also present in the home were his children.

At a table in a corner and to the side of the room, a discussion took place between Mr. Mitchell and the Scout relative to the Merit Badge subject. After a period of sitting and discussing the Merit Badge, the boy was asked to move his chair to the center of the table, and Mr. Mitchell moved his chair toward the boy. When their chairs were together Mr. Mitchell put his hand on the boy is leg and sked, "Do you mind?" The boy's response was "No, not at all. Then Mr. Mitchell started to feel around. The boy put his less together. Mr. Mitchell then asked, "Did anyone ever do that before?" The boy said "No". Mr. Mitchell said, "My, you have got a big one". The boy looked at him and it looked as if Mr. Mitchell was having an erection. Then Mr. Mitchell moved his chair away. The boy moved his chair away, but not as far as the man did. Mr. Mitchell then went on to talk about the next requirement.

Just before leaving and before the boy's father arrived to take him home, Mr. Mitchell made an appointment to go to Rocky Glen Forest Preserve. The boy was to meet Mr. Mitchell at his home at 7:30 p.m. on Wednesday, and Mr. Mitchell was to provide the transportation to and from Rocky Glen.

The boy told his mother about the above incident that same night. The mother immediately contacted the boy's Scoutmaster, who called the District Executives
