EAU GALLIE — An assistant scoutmaster has been arrested on morals charges involving more than a dozen boys in incidents that have taken place over the past year, police from three cities reported this morning.

William J. Patton, about 45 years old, who lives in Palm Bay, has been charged by Eau Gallie detectives with lewd and lascivious c o n d u c t: He will stand trial on the charges in city court tomorrow night.

Police started their investigation after parents of five boys complained to officers that Par ton was molesting the young-

Besides the five youths in Eau Gallie, Patton is accused of similar acts with five in Melbourne and three in Paim Bay. All are 12 to 14 years old.
