The enclosed correspondence tells the story. WXXXXXXX



#### CONFIDENTIAL REPORT

Ralph I. Tinker
43 Hazel Street
Uxbridge, Mass.
Age: 26 years
Scoutmaster - Troop 22 Uxbridge
Sponsored by Uxbridge Rotary Club

I received a call on Thursday, July 7th relative to the behavior of Scoutmaster Tinker. Mr. Tracy reported that neighbors and friends had reported their boys complained of attempts by Mr. Tinker to become "familiar" with them.

I made arrangements for a trip to Unbridge which I took on the same evening. After meeting Mr. Tracy, he took me to the home of Mrs. An eighbor, who had a son in the troop. In brief, Mrs. Told me the following:

Her son refused to go back to the Scout meetings after the Thundermist Camporee in April which awas held at the Uxbridge Rod and Gur Club. Several weeks later, Mrs. son told her that the Scoutmaster (Tinker) told the boys not to wear underwear to bed undermeath their pajamas, that when ready for bed, Mr. Tinker came into the boys tent and put his hands inside the boys pajama bottoms to check if they were wearing underwear to bed. Mr. remarked to his mother that Scouts were calling Mr. Tinker a queer".

I then went to see Mrs. whose son had been invited out to the Scoutmasters private camp overnight. He was alone with the Scoutmaster. During the night he reported the Scoutmaster asked him to take off all his cloths - the boy refused and the subject was dropped. Young reports that he has not dropped out of the troop but is playing Little League Baseball now and will go back to the troop when the baseball season is over.

I went to see Larry Voss, who is the Institutional Representative for Troop 22 and we discussed the situation. Mr. Voss will be holding a troop committee meeting on Wednesday July 13th at which time the dommittee will take action on ... Mr. Tinkers behavior. At this point it seemed as though there was no conclusive evidence one way or the other. I then returned to Mr. Tracy's home to report my findings to him. Mr. Tracy asked me if he should try to get a couple of other hoys to talk to me, which he did and and , who had just finished a Little League Baseball game came over to Mr. Tracy's house and talker to me. told me about the same story I had heard from his mother prior to Young meeting him. The following is the report I heard from He reports that he and two other boys whose names are 10 Fletcher , 58 Hedla Street, Uxbridge, were invited out Street, Uxbridge and to Mr. Tinkers camp overnight. While sitting around a table. Mr. Tinker completely disrobed himself and asked the boys to do the same. When the him why they all had to get undressed. Mr. Tinker replied "you will be more comfortable that way". The boy then remarked that Mr. Tinker said that he would show them how to take their pulse. After demonstrating on the wrist he said "there are ther pressure points" and immediately began handling the boys in the groin and thighs. The boys reported the next morning Mr. Tinker asked them to come down on the floor to sleep with him. When the boy refused, he was pulled down and Tinker again fondled the boy.

I am sending a note to Mr. Voss to see that the Troop Committee dismisses Mr. Tinker. When this action has been completed, we will notify the National Registration Service so that necessary action may be taken. (Mr. Tinker is getting ready to take the boys to Gmp Yawgoog for a summer camping week the week after next, so action must be taken immediately for his dismissal.
