On August 8, 1968, Howard Seitz, Scout Executive of Transatlantic Council requested that Benjamin T. Bartlett, Scoutmaster of Troop 74, Rota, Spain, be placed on the Confidential File. Mr. Seitz forwarded to this office a letter from the Troop committee chairman, Lt. Col. George F. Tubley. The following paragraph is from Col Tubley's letter.

"This action was necessitated by information which first came to the attention of the Troop Committee on Wednesday, the 17th of July. By Friday, I had made an inquiry and had established that Mr. Bartlett had during his period as Scoutmaster acted in an improper and immoral manner in his relations with the Scouts of Troops 74 and with other scouts of Rota area. My inquiry established that Mr. Bartlett had displayed homosexual tendencies and that he bade satisfied his desires in this regard by performing indecent acts with Scouts at various times."

We were also sent at the same time a letter of resignation signed by Mr. Bartlett.

At the time of the incident, Mr. Bartlett was a Petty Officer First Class in the U.S. Navy. Col. Tubley states in his letter that he notified the parent command of Mr. Bartlett and that the matter was turned over to the Naval Investigative Service Office. We do not have in our file any information concerning what happened after the investigation by the Naval authorities was made.



The identification questionnaire states that your man was never stationed in Rota, Spain. This is the key to the entire determination as to whether or not it is the same man. Our man was Scoutmaster of Troop 74 at Rota, Spain in the Transatlantic Council when he got into trouble.

The ages of the two men are exactly the same; the height and weight are pretty near the same the caloring of hair and eyes seem to be the same; the signature on the Jamboree application looks to us to be the same as the signature to have in our file on his written resignation from Troop 74 in Rota, Spain.



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

Dear Sir:

This is to inform you that it was necessary on Friday, the 19th of July 1968 to direct that Benjamin T. BARTLETT terminate immediately his duties as Scoutmaster of Troop 74, Rota, Spain. In addition, at that time, Mr. Bartlett was informed that he was to have no further contact with either the Scouts of Troop 74 or their parents in any capacity and that he was not to take part in any Scouting activity in the Rota area or in the Spain-Morocco District.

This action was necessitated by information which first came to the attention of the Troop Committee on Wednesday, the 17th of July. By Friday, I had made an inquiry and had established that Mr. Bartlett had during his period as Scoutmaster acted in an improper and immoral manner in his relations with the Scouts of Troops 74 and with other scouts of the Rota area. My inquiry established that Mr. Bartlett had displayed homosexual tendencies and that he had satisfied his desires in this regard by performing indecent acts with Scouts at various times.

 Mr. Bartlett is a Petty Offiger First Class in the U.S. Navy and is presently on active duty. He is assigned to the Naval Communication Station, Rota, Spain. My inquiry into this matter was initially for the purpose of tracking down and confirming as rumor or fact a general statement made about Mr. Bartlett. As soon as I determined that there was concrete evidence to support the statement made, I took the action described in the first paragraph of this letter. In addition. I notified the parent command of Mr. Bartlett and they requested that the Naval Investigative Service Office, Rota investigate the matter. That investigation is presently in progress and at this point it appears that charges will be placed against Benjamin T. Bartlett for violation of Article 134, Uniterm Code of Military Justice (Indecent Act with a child under the age of 16 years). The Commanding Officer, Naval Communication Station, Rota, Spain will determine what action to be taken when the results of the investigation presently being conducted are available to him. I will 

inform you of the final outcome of this matter when the action has been completed.

Enclosed is a copy of the letter of resignation submitted by Mr. Bartlett as the result of my action of July 19th.
