



Dear Howard:

As suggested by Region Two, I'm passing along the information I have concerning an incident that occurred in our Nava-Len District (Sullivan County).

Scouters in the area have indicated that Martin Boyle comes into the area frequently to help Units on week end campouts. They claim he had been introduced to them by some Scouter. This is quite vague and the answer probably will never be known.

I asked Ray Wiegand, our Executive Trainee to get a statement from the mother which is enclosed. In addition to the information in the letter, you should know that the incident was reported to the State Police by the boys. We have checked with the Police and they have the incident on record. Boyle had called back twice to see what had transpired as far as the State Police were concerned. He had claimed he was a Scoutmaster in his home area but in a later call to the Police admitted he was not registered. I had already asked Region 2 to check this prior to his call back to the barracks.

There is another incident that was apparently attempted, but that mother didn't want to cause any problem as she said nothing had been actually done.

We have notified our Scouters to use only their own know Unit people on their overnights. Boyle's name was not used at the time as we had to investigate the incident more thoroughly.

ORANGE AREA UNITED FUND

The State Police told Mrs. that she would have to swear out a warrant against Boyle if she wanted to prosecute. She declined to do so. A neighbor had originally got her quite excited, but Ray visit and the police got things on an even keel. Prompt action by Ray wiegand was of much help. The incident is closed as far as we are concerned.
