

Dear Messrs. Jacobs and Mark and the Investigatory Commission:

My thanks to you for your time in meeting with me in regard to discussing this somewhat incredible situation. Although our meeting was brief and little detail was given, it is my understanding that, at this time, there now exists three areas of concern. These arose out of the cancellation by the Fourth Presbyterian Church of the program for 1129. This was precipitated by allegations made regarding the leadership of the troop. It should here be noted that this leadership was new and made every effort to work with the Church with little or no contact or reciprocation. The issues are, as I understand them:

- 1. The Charter renewal situation;
- 2. Background and activities of myself;
- 3. The alleged 1970 incident or something that took place 11 years ago.

I would like to have any and all information pertaining to these as soon as possible. $\begin{tabular}{ll} \hline \end{tabular}$

Though this entire situation is appalling from the way it has evolved and the direct aggravation and embarrassment it's causing me personally in business and community activities, as I indicated to you in our meeting, I will be more than happy to assist and to cooperate in any way that will bring this to a speedy and mutually acceptable conclusion.

For an excess of 30 years, Scouting has meant a lot to me. It is, in many cases the only vehicle that is capable under concerned leadership of making direct positive changes in the lives of young people. This I have found to be the case with the many delinquent, pre-delinquent and neglected children that I have in one capacity or another worked with over the years.
