A verrant was issued for Kelly and he appeared before a Judge in Palatka, Florida and was bound over to the next session of the Circuit Court. He was released on bond and since that time we have heard of two other similar incidents. We are now being succeed for \$20,000 by the parents of the victim at Camp and the suit is being defended by Attorneys acting for the INA Insurance Company. Up to the present time nothing has appeared in the newspapers concerning this incident. We will try to keep you informed about this matter as it develops.
