

Watson's closest friend is a 16 year old how by the name watson's closest friend is a 16 year old how by the name of . He was investigated last year by the Army because of his close association with the boy. I believe the investigation was more of an inquiry and not carefully done. He took the boy on a western trip last year for some three weeks. At the request of the Oswego County Council, the Army supplied an ambulance and a corpsman -- our same Mr. Watson. I found out later that the boy also spent the weekend with him. I alerted two of our key Scouters to report to me any irregular activities of Watson, and I questioned his good judgement.

About two or three weeks ago one of our commissioners's sons, who lives in the nearby community of Black River, stopped at the dispensary to see the dental officer. Watson was at the dispensary looking at a booklet of new sports cars. Like any 16 year old, the row said "dee, I wish I had the money to buy a car like that." Watson said to the boy, "I know how you can make some money. I have a poloroid camera and all you have to do is take your picture. I can sail them for a lot officer to an outfit down south." The sell them for a lot of money to an outfit down south." boy seid "I've got to go. I'll see you, Buzz." Watson I suppose you the tell your father." -- which he did. The said "I suppose you'll tell your father." -- which he did. I father immediately called the District Executive serving his area, who called Major Rebeor, the troop committee chairman.

Since Watsan was in the army, I met with the Commanding Officer who seemed his dosier from Intellegence. He was a suspected homesexual and treated in 1952 and again in 1955. The Colone legotild not understand why he was not discharged.

Watson was due to be transferred to Viet Nam about a year ago, and was suddenly hospitalized for a severed achilles tendons which he claimed he received while hiking. While there ngaproof, the Army personnel believe it was self-inflicted. A NEED

Watson currently has black hair; previously has been a red head and a blonde. He has had some fact lifting work done.

The Colonel said he is due to appear for an Army medical. review, because of his foot infuky sometime in Jamuary. does have over 20 years in, and could be medically discharged shortly.

In your letter you stated that based on an incident that occurred two weeks ago and your talk with Watson's Commanding Officer, Watson has been removed from all Scouting activities. We would appreciate your advising us just what incident occurred. We really should have more details regarding this matter. Won't you please write us as complete a report as possible regarding this situation.

Enclosed is a confidential record sheet which we would also appreciate your filling out and returning to us, together with the above requested information and any substantiating documents that may be available pertaining to this case. This additional information will enable us to identify Mr. Watson should be ever again attempt to register in the Scouting program. Thanks for your kind cooperation. tion.

I am sure you realize that this leaves Troop 26 without any registered unit leader. Undoubtedly, someone is taking over in this position. In order for the unit to continue to reserve program inserts in Scouting Magazine, it will be necessary to advise this office of the hame of the new unit leader. This should be done by filing with us an additional enrollment for this individual in his new position. Please to not fire a separation notice as we have already dropped the current leader.

He has been registered as an Associate Advisor with Post 26, and Assistant Scoutmaster and Scoutmaster with Troop 26, at Camp Drum, N. Y.

He has received psychological treatment from the Army for perversion in 1952 and again in 1955. Based on an incident two weeks ago and my discussion with the Commanding Officer, he has been removed from all Scouting activities and his current registration card is being mailed to me, which I will destroy. He has extensive tenure in Scouting and is due for a medical review in about two weeks and will probably be discharged, and leaving this area. leaving this areas
