On the night of April 22, 1961, I, my husband and my son were visiting in the home of Mr. R. H. Albrecht. Mr. R. H. Albrecht's address is 4010 Ella Blvd., Houston. Texas. and my son Mr. R. H. Albrech

About 9 p.m. Gene Albrecht arrived. Our son age 10, and Joe Albrecht age 8, and Cassandra Albrecht age 5 (The children of Mr. R. H. Albrecht), were playing in the yard. After being there for age 10, and about ten minutes and drinking a cup of coffee, Gene went out into the yard. We could hear the children shouting and playing. Suddenly they were very quiet. I went to investigate, and and Gene Albrecht came from behind the house. Being suspicious of Gene Albrecht's conduct because of some stories we had heard previously. I took aside in one of the bedrooms and questioned him. stated that Gene Albrecht had put his hand inside his trousers and played with him. said that he started towery out, but that Gene Albrecht put his hand over his () mouth

Is accused Gene Albrecht of this epenly, and he (Gene Albrecht) denied his actions My husband and I took and left immediately.

The entire Albrecht family are lifelong acquaintances of my husband, so we have brought no formal charges with the police as yet. However, we may do so if the family does not see to it that Gene Albrecht is given some sort of treatment or put under some restraint. We feel that he (Gene Albrecht) is a mentally-sick person.

It is our understanding that Gene Albrecht has been associated with the Boy Scout movement for several years, as well as some church youth organization.

It is our contention and desire that Gene Albrecht be no longer allewed to participate in any of these youth movements, and it is the

main purpose of this letter to emphasize that point.

We have heard that he has a past record/history of child molestation. We have no facts or information/any previous offenses, but feel that the facts that we do have warrant some action in removing this man (Gene Albrecht) from direct association with any children, anywhere, anytime.






Four things need to be emphasized

- 1. has been consistent in his statements concerning the alleged incident between Wes Andreen and himself. Additionally, it is not in the character to intentionally hurt anyone or to lie to get someone in trouble. In our opinion, his statement is credible.
- 2. Through this whole incident we have been extremely careful to protect the confidentiality of Wes Andreen and Wes Andreen has made public the allegations through his conversations with our Scouts and other adult Scouters not associated with B.S.A. Troop 144. We never even discussed this matter with our own troop committee until after Wes Andreen put the accusations out on the street!
- 3. We all really liked Wes Andreen and were extremely proud when he achieved Eagle Scout. He was always willing to help the Troop out. It hurt when we had to tell Wes that he no longer had the privilege to attend our Troop meetings or participate in Troop activities. But the risk to our Scouts had to be minimized.
- Wes Antireen attended summer camp in July 1993 as an adult, not as a Scout (he tunned eighteen (18) in March or April 1993). He has never filled out an application to register as an adult Scouter with B.S.A. Troop 144.
