Gentlemen:

Mr. Steve Bailey, Muskingum Valley Council District Executive serving the Yandata District (#4), called me long distance concerning Mr. John Denton, Institutional Representative of Pack 412, Warsaw, Ohio, sponsored by the Lions Club.

Bailey had just returned from a visit to Judge Ross, Judge of the Probate Court, Coshocton County. The Judge had let Mr. Bailey read Denton's confession in which he was involved in morals cases against four boys, three of whom were Scouts in Troop 412.

Judge Ross has committed Denton to the Cambridge State Hospital for observation and psychopathic examination. The parents have signed legal complaints. The disposition of the case will depend upon the outcome of the examination at the Cambridge Hospital.

John Denton is a bachelor, six feet three inches tall, has a speech defect which results in a rather mushy or slurred speech, has a heavy beard, and weighs around two hundred pounds.

Inasmuch as this is a matter for the courts, I have not attempted to secure individual complaints from the parents of the boys. If you need this information, in addition to the fact that there will be a legal trial, please let me know.

I am indeed sorry to have to write this letter.
