
MEMO TO FILE

Thomas E. Donahue came to the Sheraton Boston Hotel and met me in my room on Tuesday, May 20 at 10:30 A.M..

After preliminary discussion, Mr. Donahue readily admitted that he had received an undesirable discharge from the military service because of homosexual activities with two Scouts in Troop 20, El Paso, Texas. These activities consisted of acts of masturbation.

Mr. Donahue is 26 years of age and is still single.

I advised Mr. Donahue that there was little, if any, chance that we would be willing to ever again accept his registration in the Boy Scouts of America and that the only possibility would be the result of either denial of original facts, which is not possible in this situation, or written documentation from recognized medical authority and/or psychiatrist that he (Mr. Donahue) has completed treatment and that he is completely cured and such incident will never again occur.

Thank you for your letter of December 30, 1964 enclosing the report of Lt. Col. Charles G. Wood and profile sheet concerning Edward Thomas Donahue, Jr., former Scoutmaster of Troop 20.

Although the report indicates that there is information which makes it necessary to cancel Mr. Donahue's registration with the Boy Scouts of America, we must have more definite information before we can take action on your letter.

Colonel Wood's report states that Donahue "was discharged from the United States Air Force on November 24, 1964 under 'other than honorable' conditions in accordance with the provisions of AFR 35-66. Just what does this mean? What is the nature of this situation?

Please write us a more detailed letter including a complete report on this situation so we will be able to determine how this case should be handled.

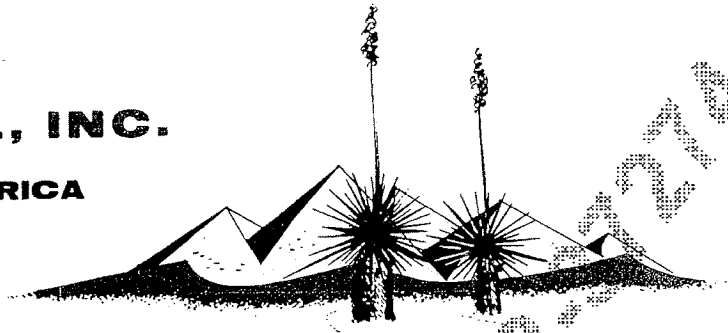
