

Please place the name of Benjamin C. Forsterling, Scoutmaster of Troop 24, Elkhart Lake, Wisconsin, in our confidential file at once.

The Sheboygan County Sheriff's Department has found had guilty of having abnormal relations with a number of boys

This has been substantiated by a lie detector test which Mr. Forsterling underwent in Madison, Wisconsin, by detailed statements from several boys and by a psychiatrist who is treating him.

The ironic part of it is that he has established a record as instructor for the American Red Cross for many years, has served as Chief of Police of Elkhart Lake, Wisconsin and has been in Scouting since April 1931.
