It is with regret that I report on an investigation made by Deputy Regional Executive, Bill Davis, and me, into a report we received on Gleston Freeman, 1200 Apache St., Winslow, Arizona; age 36, Catholic. He is currently registered as District Commissioner and has been very active in Scouting for some 15 years.

According to reports received from the Fistrict Chairman who made a check into the situation. Gleston has been accused of child molestation and has been fired from his job as an elementary school teacher. The teachers and school administrators have gone so far as to make it impossible for him to remew his credential to teach.

Upon hearing the report; Bill, who happened to be in Flagstaff on other business, and I nade a trip to Winslow and found out from the elementary school principal, of 609 Aspinwall, Winslow, Arizona, for whom he had taught, that the charges had been confirmed. There has not been a public hearing nor is one contemplated, but there is no doubt, supported by his own confession, that Gleston Freeman, on numerous occassions has molested girl members of the fifth grade class which he taught.

It is therefore our recommendation that he be declared ineligable for membership in the Boy Scouts of America.



Mr. informed us that upon investigation into his previous employment record he found that Mr. Freeman had been fired for the same reason from his teaching jobs in Cottonwood and Phoenix.
