On your recent Transmittal #74, you included the registration for Troop 222, sponsored by the Kassel American School, Parent-Teachers Association, Kassel, Germany. Listed on the charter application was one Jerry W. Funkhouse who indicated he is approximately 23 years of age and a Separated-Registered Scouter.

We do believe that he is the same individual as one Jerry W. Funkhouser on whom we have information indicating that we cannot accept his registration as a leader with the Boy Scouts of America. Just to confirm our belief of this, you might ascertain whether Mr. Funkhouse was ever connected as an Assistant Scoutmaster with Troop 203, Dunkirk, Indiana from October, 1961 until relieved a few months later.

If our judgement is correct, we cannot accept Mr. Funkhouse's registration and we are returning, herewith, his registration fee of \$1.00. If our identification proves wrong, you may resubmit his application.

Concerning the report I requested in my letter of February 9, you may recall that in Ray Starkey's letter of December 6, he also requested this, indicating that it was needed to properly classify the case. Also, there is only one confidential file which is in the home office, and all information should be kept in it.

You may be assured that any such records or statements which are sent to us are completely confidential and the information given is neither shared or discussed with others. If you wish, you may mention this to the individuals involved.

Certainly, if you know them well enough, you can explain the importance of such information in helping us to prevent such individuals from associating with Scouting in the future.

After the meeting on the 13th he confessed to these acts to the President of the Lions Club, Lavon Edwards, The committee chairman Minor Burgess, and the Scoutmaster Arlan Dalhaus.

Some of the parents are aware of what is going on but we are trying to hush it up, for the benefit of the program.
