Marvin Marks, director Lime Lake Camp, Vince Kappone, commissioner and myself talked to Bill as soon as it was brought to our attention by Scoutingster who had talked to the boys involved.

We confronted him with the morals situation and he did not deny it. We in turn talked to him on what we were goIng to do and what we thought he should do. We recommended that he resign his position immediately and that he go to his summer home where his mother is now staying. Vince and harve helped him pack and we took him into town where he is to meet a friend who will take his luggage and himself to Detroit and then up North.

We told him that if the boys told their parents and the parents wanted to press charges, this they could do. I like told kim I did not know what the Council would do but that Mr. Leist knew about it, as he happened to be in Camp at the time, and that I was sure he would tell Mr. Specht who was now out at the Ranch. We also advised him to seek Medical and any Legal help NOW.

Bill made no denial of the accusation and his only response was that he was very sorry for anything he might accidence. In all fairness I should say that he did a better that adverage job as Field Sports Director and a good job of managing the farm house staff as far as keeping the place neet and clean.
