This information will enable us to identify Mr. Hawks, should he ever again attempt to register in the Scouting program.

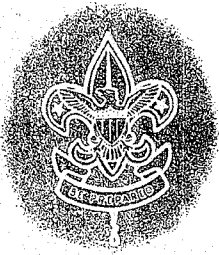


