

My Dear Mr. Burgess:

Within the last two weeks there has come to my attention a matter about which I believe you ought to be informed because of your position as Scout Executive, Far East Council Box Scouts of America.

A young man attached to this command, HOUGH, David John; 587 11 82, JO3, USN, Assistant Scoutmaster of Atsugi Troop - 22, has admitted committing a number of homosexual acts with various dependent male children over a period extending to mearly one year. HOUGH's complete confession followed shortly upon an accusation made by one of the boys involved. A Navy psychiatrist who inter-viewed him concluded that HOUGH possessed significant homosexual tendencies.

Subsequently, HOUGH requested that he be discharged from the naval service under conditions other than honorable in order to escape trial by court-martial. The request received favorable endorsement by me and has been forwarded for final action by the Chief of Naval Personnel. Pending action by the Chief of Naval Personnel, HOUGH has been transferred to the U. S. Naval Receiving Station, Treasure Island, California,

I am bringing this matter to your attention because I feel that it is important that action be taken to preclude HOUGH's further participation in Boy Scout activities so long as he continues to suffer from his present sexual maladjustment. For your further information I am enclosing two pictures of HOUGH together with some descriptive data and his home address.

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. be of further assistance please do not hesitate to let me know.
