- 1. Mr. Everett H. Smith, District Scout Executive, has requested that I furnish you with details of the circumstances surrounding the discharge of Airman First Class James M. Hungate, date of birth 23 November 1936, for the purpose of a permanent record to be maintained at Scout Headquarters.
- 2. On 1 October 1959, James M. Hungate and his wife, in response to an advertisement placed by a valparaiso, Florida, went to home to inquire concerning a house Mr. Eardley had for rent in Mary Esther, Florida, and their 10-year old daughter, and Mr. and Mrs. Hungate, drove in the station wason to Mary Esther, Florida, where they looked at the piece of property.
- 3. While examining the premises, Airman Hungate put his arm around the shoulder of the but made no further advances. While proceeding back to Valparaiso, were in the front of the automobile, Mr. Eardley as the driver. In the rear Betty sat directly behind her father. On her right was Airman Hungate, and directly on his right was Mrs. Hungate. As the car was being driven, Airman Hungate put his hard under dress inside her panties, and placed his hand on her genital erea. gave no outcry, but immediately after the Hungates were left off at their residence, told her parents wastly what had happened, explaining that she was too scared to say anything while Airman Hungate was still in the car.
- 4. Upon being questioned by the Office of Special Investigations, Airman Hungate made a full confession, stating, "I put my hand, or finger, inside the leg of her panties, and rubbed her abdomen in that general area.
- The Airman Hungate was placed in the Neuropsychiatric Clinic of the

United States Air Force Hospital, Eglin Air Force Base, Florida, for observation. After more than a month of examination, and a board of two psychiatrists, an evaluation was made of: "Sexual Deviate (pedophilia), chronic, moderate, manifested by sexual interests in small girls and one episode of fondling". The diagnosis further stated that he was legally sane and free from mental defect, disease, or derangement.

- 6. Originally court-martial action was contemplated, but upon the refusal of the to allow their daughter to testify, Airman Hungate was administratively separated under the provisions of AFR 39-17 for sexual perversion, and was furnished an undesirable discharge in December, 1959.
- 7. Airman Hungate is Caucasian, was born in Roanoke, Virginia, and his wife's name is Miriam W. Hungate. He lists on his records a home address of 1228 Stewart Street, Roanoke, Virginia. His height is 72 inches; his weight is 249 pounds; his hair color is red; and his eyes are green.
- 8. If there is any further information I can furnish you regarding this man, please do not hesitate to write to me.
