Edward Jennings was charged with eight (8) counts if indecent assault. An investigating police lieutenant believes that there were more counts that could have been lodged against this man, but felt that sufficient evidence had been obtained to gain a conviction. The charges were charged to two (2) counts of indecent assault and four (4) counts of risk of injury to a minor Edward Jennings pleaded guilty to the four (4) counts of risk of injury to a minor and was sentenced on Friday, December 3, 1965, in Superior Court, 121 Elis Street, New Haven, Connecticut, by Judge Meyers, one (1) year and one (1) day on the First count. He was sentenced to the same term on counts 2,3;4, to be served consurrently.

The Branford Police Department felt that he had received a relatively light sentence because he is a first offender and had served as a Scoutmaster. He may be eligible for parole in ten (10) months
