SUBJECT: William Keen, Advisor Ship 58

In my opinion, Mr. Keen should not be acceptable for registration in Scouting in any position. In previous years Mr. Keen was the Advisor of Ship 55 which is sponsored by the Newport Optimist Club. During 1958 and 1959 in the recharter month (March), the Optimist Club Committee met, signed the Ship Charter and paid their registration fees, the Charter papers were then given to Mr. Keen for his signature and registration fee and of course for the boy members of the Ship, he was then to bring or mail the Reregistration papers to the Dan Beard Council office. This did not happen though almost daily follow-up was made by the Officers of the Optimist Club, the District Executive and the Neighborhood Commissioner, during both of these years final meetings were held in June and Optimist Club Members, again paid to register, no reasonable excuse was offered by Mr. Keen for this action.

In 1960 the Optimist Club insisted that fr. Keen resign from this position as Advisor, this was accomplished after much difficulty and agitation.

There are also many other unsavory stories connected with Mr. Keen and though I personally have no proof of these rumors there must be some basis for them considering that these stories have come from widespread areas and sources within the District.

I firmly believe that Mr. Keen's nature would not be compatible to the best interest of Scouting.
