Gary Kissel was registered as an Assistant Scoutmaster of Troup 103, Dover. during its last registration period, ending March 1960. It became a lapsed unit and did not get registered until May 1960. The lapsed status was due to the lapsed lity of the Institutional Representative to sign up the men from the signsoring institution whom he wanted on the committee. The unit itself was functioning very well the time; i.e., troop meetings regularly, and special activities.

During the lapsed period (April) several conts of the troop reported to their Scoutmaster and parents that they were being modested by hissel. The reports were checked out and found to be true. The Scoutnaster metorted the affair to me and asked me for my advice. Since the accused is a member of T.V.S. Are Force, I suggested that he be turned over to military authorities. In my presence, it is scoutmaster dismissed the accused from all connection with the troop and told him he was turning him over to his commanding officer for action. In the meantime, the troop re-registered, and the accused was dropped from the unit.

I now have a report from the court martial of Gary Kissel was held last week, that he was found guilty of the charges, was given one year of hard labor, forfeited all pay and allowances, art will be dishonorably discharged from the

ikani. (A few days before has trial; trial; was informed he had attempted suicide.)

Although he was not rectuelly registered in Scouting at the time of his trial, he was registered when the charges were made: I should think this information should be given to Basil Starkey at National for his action. If and when you report this to Starkey, will you please furnish a copy of your latter to the Office of Special Investigation, lover Air Force Base, Down Del. Any questions you may have should be directed to that office, also.
