

Dear Ray,

By telephone conversation with John Friskey, Institutional Representative for Plymouth Congregational Church, on July 26, 1965, I Tearned that Malcolm McConahy had been arrested within the past couple days in Wisconsin Rapids, Wisconsin. This was on a misdemeanor charge for circulation of pernographic material. The Wisconsin Rapids police had contacted Detective McNamara of the Minneapolis Police Department, and Detective McNamara notified Friskey.

McConahy was supposedly on his way to New York City to live and seek employment. He was in the company of four boys from Wisconsin Rapids at the time of his arrest. He had given sums of money to all four boys, varying from sixty to ten dollars. He had a large amount of money or his person and from this, put up his own bail, which amounted to \$40,000, (four hundred dollars).

McConahy included in his story to Wisconsin Rapids police the fact that he had been discharged from service at an Assistant Scoutmaster at Plymouth Church and as a result of this, had lost a number of friends; consequently he felt that it would be better to live elsewhere.

Perhaps this letter should be used to add this bit of information with the material which has already been forwarded to the National Office.





Gentlemen:

The following individuals, whose signatures appear on this letter and who represent the adult troop leadership, troop committee and sponsoring institution, have found it necessary to relieve Mr. Malcolm McConahy of his responsibilities as an Assistant Scoutmaster for Troop 27, Boy Scouts of America. The sponsoring institution is Plymouth Congress tronal Church, 1900 Nicollet Avenue, Minneapolis, Minnesota.

The reason for suspending Mr. McConahy from future activity with this troop is supported by evidence obtained and an admission by Mr. McConahy of homosexual interests and activities involving certain boys within Troop 27 and himself. This admission was obtained in the course of an interview between Mr. McConahy and the undersigned, and in addition to acknowledging his involvement, Mr. Mcconahy expressed interest in seeking help for himself and also concern for those boys with whom he was involved. It remains to be seen whether this attitude on the part of Mr. McConahy will continue to be maintained.
