It is with great regret that I have to advise you that one of our local men who was registered in Scouting for one year should be red flagged. The gentlemen concerned is Ralph Eugene Moore registered is Cubmaster of Pack 8 in our District No. 2 from October 1958 until October 1959. This man has been found guilty of morals offenses against two juverile boys, ages 9 and 11, and has been sentenced to the Washington State Penicentiary for 20 years. He is eligible for parole in approximately four years if he exhibits good behavior. While his offenses were directed to two boys who were related to him, they occurred during the time he was Submaster and the younger of the two boys was active in the Cub Fack.

This man was born in Cashmere in December 1919. He is single. The police analyze his problem as chronic and urge that he never again be permitted to register in the Boy Scout program.
