Ex-Camp Aide Sentenced On Morals Complaint

A college student, who doubled as an assistant scout master and camp counsellor, drew a term at the Vacaville State Medical Facility from Superior Judge William F. James yesterday on a sex charge.

Edward Troy Smith, 21, of 3208 El Camino Real, pleaded guilty to charges that while serving as a baby-sitter for a San Jose family he committed three acts of perversion with the family's six-year-old son.

Smith told the court that for 11 years he had been associated with the Boy Scouts, as a Scout and assistant scout leader, and "had never had any difficulty or been involved in any difficulty with any of the boys with whom he had been associated."

Psychiatrists at the Atascadero State Hospital

reported to the court that after a 90-day observation period, they concluded Smith "was a sexual psychopath, is a menace to the health and safety of others, and will not benefit by care or treatment at the hospital."

Judge James said he hoped that Smith may receive some beneficial treatment at the Vacaville Department of Mental Hygiene.
