Molesting Case Guilt Admitted

Joseph Ray Schuerman, 24, E307 Augusta, pleaded guilty in Superior Court yesterday to an indecent liberties charge involving an 11-year-old boy.

Judge Ralph P. Edgerton deferred sentencing and acting on a state petition alleging Schuerman to be a sexual psychopath, ordered him committed to a state hospital for 90 days' observation.

If the observation shows him to be a sexual psychopath, he will be committed as such; if not, he will be returned to court for sentencing on the criminal charge.

Deputy Pros. Atty. John P. Murray said Schuerman had received probation in Oregon in 1963 on a check charge and was sentenced to prison in Seattle that same year on a grand larceny count, reduced from robbery. He was paroled in September, 1966.

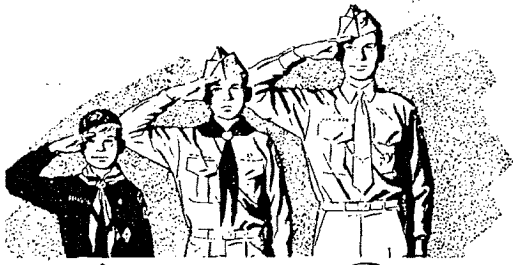
