

Sodomy Charged In Assaults Against Two In Scout Troop

A 42-year-old north St. Louis Boy Scout leader was charged Monday with solomy in connection with sexual assaults on two boys in his troop, police said.

Authorities said the troop was formed about three weeks ago and police were uncertain as to whether it had been certified officially.

The alleged assaults were said to have occurred on two separate occasions when members of the troop stayed

overnight at the suspect's home. One assault was reported to have been made on a 13-year-old boy on April 20, when about five youths spent the night after getting home late from an outing to a drive-in theater.

The second alleged incident occurred Wednesday night and involved a 15-year-old boy who with two other boys was staying overnight.
