#### Dear Paul:

The attached complaints were provided at our request after a verbal complaint by parents regarding the possible behavior of one Gene Judson Sowder. This situation was handled by me in the following manner:

- 1. March 30, 1979. Mrs. came to our Service Center and demanded something be done to protect her son. Our Exploring Executive tried to calm her, and asked her to give us until Monday to check it out.
- 2. April 2, 1979. Field Director called parents and asked for written parental complaint.
- 3. April 3, 1979. The attached complaints were brought to the Service Center.
- 4. April 3, 1979. Scout Executive shared problem with Scouting Coordinator of Post #2360, sponsored by Burlington Industries.
- 5. April 4, 1979. Scout Executive and Field Director met with Personnel Manager and Post Committee Chairman at Burlington Industries to strategize methods to handle the situation. Burlington Industries felt that they could do little or nothing because of current state of the law protecting an employee in non-job performance related areas. Two alternatives seemed apparent, a) legal action on the part of the parents, or b) direct contact with the leader by Scout Officials.
- 6. April 4, 1979. Scout Executive and Field Director met with Mr. Sowder and informed him of the complaints. Outcome:
  - A. Mr. Sowder is not registered now.
  - B. He has agreed not to attempt to register.
  - C. He is a former Professional Scouter at Richmond, Va.
  - D. He has agreed to withdraw from all activity in the Explorer Program.
