

We the Parents of and and , after questioning our sons have written their statements, honestly and truthfully. To submit over two years of incidents with dates and places is impossible in case.

We have worked and believed in the Boy Scouts of America for years, we have entrusted our three sons to Mr. John Quick, Scoutmaster. So we believe that the Boy Scouts of America should handle this situation, but after your investigation and confortation if any retaliation abainst our sons should occur, we will immediately contact the Royal Oak Youth Bureau for their protection.

On September 2I, I978 this was brought to our attention by Mrs. T. Nichols at a P.T.A. Meeting, at home we awakened and asked our sons, "if Mr. Quick had ever put his hands in their underwear?" Their answers were, "Yes." Mr. Jack M Nie was called immediately.

It is to our knowledge that other boys in Troop I604 have been approached by Mr. John Quick.

I () nave been under care by Dr. Robert Weitzman M.D. and Dr. Phillip Freidman M.D. Psychiatry, counseling has been advised for our sons, especially as soon as possible, because of their humiliation and guilt feelings. Therefore we ask that this investigation be kept confidential and discreet.

Some time ago after seeing the picture of the boys, Danny Quick and , I became suspicious and questioned Boo if Mr. Quick had ever done anything funny? But did not further the situation when he answered, "no."

On camp-outs, during summer camp, always unwitnessed until this summer at Lost Lake in which, witness, supposedly sleeping, the approach of Mr. Quick in the tent trying to undress in Mis sleeping bag for a "Birthday Spanking" in which fought him off.

's only comment is that he thought for the two years, he was the only chosen one, to whom these incidents have occured to until this years summer camp.

This is the statement requested by you, from giving facts of incidents caused by Mr. John Quick, beginning May 1978.

- 1. At Mr. Quick's home a Tenderfoot Requirement Meeting: Attended by Robert anderson, John McNie, Andy Mace, and Mr. Quick asked to go into his camper outside to try on used Scout slacks, was told to remove his underwear, he then performed an extended physical examination checking for ruptures. Was told this had to be done so that he could attend camp.
- 2. On two other occasions in July 1978, Mr. Quick Picked up here from home and took him to his house under the guise of tr/in, on uniforms. The physical examination was then repeated two more times. These examinations did cause him pain from the poking and proding.
- 3. birthday spankings are given on Mr. Quick*s lap after he has removed their Jeans and underwear;

 - 2. Lost Lake Boy Scout Camp-August 1978 We asked if anyone was in camp at the time and Lenny said, "No."
