Thank you for your letter of December 8th concerning Mr. Ron St. Laurent. This information is most helpful to us and will certainly enable us to refuse registration attempts. We hope you will keep us informed as any legal action takes place.

We do find, in checking our files, that an individual by this name is on our file who had once lived in Leavenworth, Kansas. We believe it is very possible this is the same individual.

Unfortunately, the computer file has difficulty when you have names which are abbreviated, such as "St.," and have periods or do not have periods. We have, therefore, entered the name on our files in several different configurations to make certain that this "slip" of allowing a registration to get through the system does not again occur.

Let us know if we may be of more help to you in this process.

When the Child Molestation was alledged in late October, we asked Mr. St. Laurent to remove himself voluntarily from leadership of Troop 13 pending police investigation. Today these new charges and the arrest was made. The police will confirm to us in writing, which we will forward to you.

My understanding is that Mr. St. Laurent was also a Scouter at one time in Flagstaff. The police are checking this as well. I will keep you apprised of new developments. Mr. St. Laurent is currently being held by the Phoenix Police on the charges indicated on the form.

I am sorry that I cannot provide you with "a copy of the police or court record, newspaper clippings and signed statements from individuals involved" ...regarding Ronald A. St. Laurent.

Acting on information from a reliable source, as Scout Executive of the Heart of America Council, I took the following action. I invited Mr. St. Laurent to my office and with a witness present told him that we could not accept his registration in the Boy Scouts of America. I returned his registration fee and tore up his application in front of him. At the same time I informed him that we had information that I was not at liberty to disclose that caused us to take such action. I likewise informed him that he could only secure the information by getting an attorney. At that point he confessed that he had a bad record, in fact, he told us what had happened while in the military and there is no question that he must be kept out of Scouting.

I realize that we live in a day and age where you cannot go on hearsay, but I would also submit that we live in a day and age where police departments, government organization and/or individuals are going to protect themselves from any repercussion. Sorry I can't provide you with more information.
