FIRST:	That he shall not during the term of his probation, violate any criminal law of the State of Michigan, or of any other State or of any ordinance of any municipality.					
SECOND:	That he shall not during the term of his probation leave the State without the consent of this Court.					
THIRD:	That he shall report to the Probation Agent, in writing and in person at a time set by the Probation Agent. He shall inform the Probation Agent, prior to any change of address or employment.					
FOURTH:	That he shall absolutely refrain and desist from the use or possession in any manner of illegal drugs prohibited by the Controlled Substance Act.					
FIFTH:	That he absolutely refrain and desist from the use in any manner of all intoxicating liquors, or furnishing liquors to others, and that he refrain from entering taverns, pool rooms, or other places where gaming tables are kept or run, or where any gaming devices are kept or operated in any manner whatsoever.					
SIXTH:	That he shall not engage in any anti-social conduct which shall furnish good cause to this Court to believe that this probationary order should be revoked in the public interest.					
SEVENTII:	That he spend the first <u>six (5)</u> digr/months in the Lenawee County Jail with credit for time served from/for <u>No Credit</u>					
EIGHTII:	That he shall be gainfully employed or enrolled in a school or training program approved by the probation agent.
