Today I spoke with Mr. ______, Scoutmaster of Troop 425.
Mr. _____ has been involved with the Boy Scout troop for
4 years as Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmaster. Mr. ______
spoke with me about alledged homosexual activity within the
troop that involved Joe Kikta and several Boy Scouts.

Mr. told me that the following information based on a conversation he had with his son has been at Joe Kikta's house on at least 3 occasions since the summer of 1984. On each occasion has been disrobed and touched and/or fondled in the genital area by Joe Kikta. On many other occasions has been invited by Joe Kikta to participate in assortment of "Dare Games" that eventually involved disrobing.

Also, Mr. indicated several other Boy Scouts in the troop have had the same experience as

According to Mr. _____ the State H.R.S. Department is investigating these allegations and in the process of interviewing all alleged involved participants.

Mr. has agreed to continue his own investigation and will report any additional information to John Malone as soon as possible. The Troop Committee Chairman has dismissed Joe Kikta from the Troop (See attached letter) and is in the process of informing the institutional head of all activities within the next several days.






If there is any legal action taken, we would like to know the outcome of this. In the mean time, thanks so much for all your help.



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We also recommended that if there is any reason to believe Joe Kikta to be involved, that the troop should take action to remove him and inform the council. We suggested we need a written statement for us to take further action.


On Tuesday, May 7, Mr. Bechler contacted me by phone and reported that the H.R.S. investigator had interviewed both Joe Kikta and and both boys denied any wrongdoing. He also said that the official finding would be that the charges were unfounded but that he felt he had not gotten the truth. Mr. Bechler said he met with on Tuesday and informed him of the charges and action taken to date. He said Mr. agreed to follow-up with his son and would keep us informed.

Mr. Bechler also told me he had recieved a call from another mother I who related another incident from the same campout at Grace Lutheran. She said her son had been "accousted" by Joe Kikta in the restroom and forced to watch a "demonstration of how the sexual organ (penis) works." I again indicated a need for the troop to take action as well as the need for a written statement to allow the council to act.

On Wednesday, May 8th contacted me by phone and informed me that his son had confirmed Joe Kikta's involvement with homosexual activity and that his son would be making a report to the H.R.S. to give us the ability to act in a proper manner. Indicated they would remove Joe Kikta from Troop 425 and inform us.

Also on the same evening David Bechler contacted me to confirm that Mr. had called me. He indicated one of the boys who had talked to him originally may be willing to talk to the investigators. He raised a concern about the boy's Eagle application that I feel we resolved. He also indicated that Earl Boyette had been implicated as involved with similar charges.

Dear Mr. Kikta:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that BSA leadership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth. Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA leader should be reinstated.



On Saturday, May 4, David Bechler, an Assistant Scoutmaster in Troop 425-of Grace Lutheran Church spoke with
Larry Thompson, District Commissioner, Bill Ortt, Sr.
District Executive and John Malone, Director of Field
Service. He related an incident stemming from a Patrol
Campout he attended at a mission church on the Miccosukee
Indian Reservation.

He reported that two members of the troop, Joe Kikta, 18 years old and ______, 14 years, were on the campout but he could not find them. While asking about them two other Scouts responded about their whereabouts in a way that aroused suspicion. He questioned both of them both together and separately. They both indicated that ______ and Joe were suspected to be involved homosexually. The two boys related reasons for these suspicions relating to another campout held in February or March at Grace Lutheran Church in Miami Springs. One of the boys said that ______ had asked him to demonstrate a "blow job" in such a way he felt ______ was serious. It was also related that Joe had gotten involved in a "strip dare game" that led to him running around the camping area in his underwear and "sliding in the grass." He apparently was the only adult at this camping experience.

Mr. Bechler told us that he was a Police Officer in Miami Springs and that he had related this information to his Police Chief, who recommended his contacting H.R.S. to secure an investigator trained in this type of incident. We suggested that Mr. Bechler should contact and inform Mr. George Gates, the troop's Scoutmaster and the father of as soon as possible. We indicated that the Boy Scouts of America, and the South Florida Council would in no way want to impede or inhibit any criminal or legal action but would suggest and reports filed should bear only pertinant information, ideally not specifically naming the Scouting organization, but instead recognizing this to be an incident between individuals.
